FITTING PROCEDURE 1. Remove O.E stone shields and retain ALL mounting bolts for later use. NOTE: Straighten mount brackets if damaged. 2. Fit front panel to vehicle using original bolts. Leave bolts finger tight. ARE 3. Once front panel is mounted fit an M8 cage nut to centre square hole as shown. 4. Lift sump panel into position and secure to cross member using original bolts. Fit an M8 cage nut to rear centre of panel when done.
